# THE THREE PILLARS OF THE BRIDGE OF HOPE PROGRAM

## Rental Assistance

Upon their acceptance into Bridge of Hope, moms are offered rental assistance on a decreasing basis. As they grow in stability, rental assistance reduces until the families are entirely independent.

## Case Management

Single moms are paired with case managers. These family advocates work with families to reduce debt, set healthy boundaries, heal from trauma, look for opportunities for career growth, and more.

## Neighboring Volunteers

We partner with the local faith communities to provide support to these families. This creates new and essential relationships for the families while allowing churches to be the hands and feet of Jesus to their community.

Over a one-to-two year period, this combination of resources empowers families to become self-sufficient so that they never face homelessness again.

17 families including 43 kids participated in the Bridge of Hope program

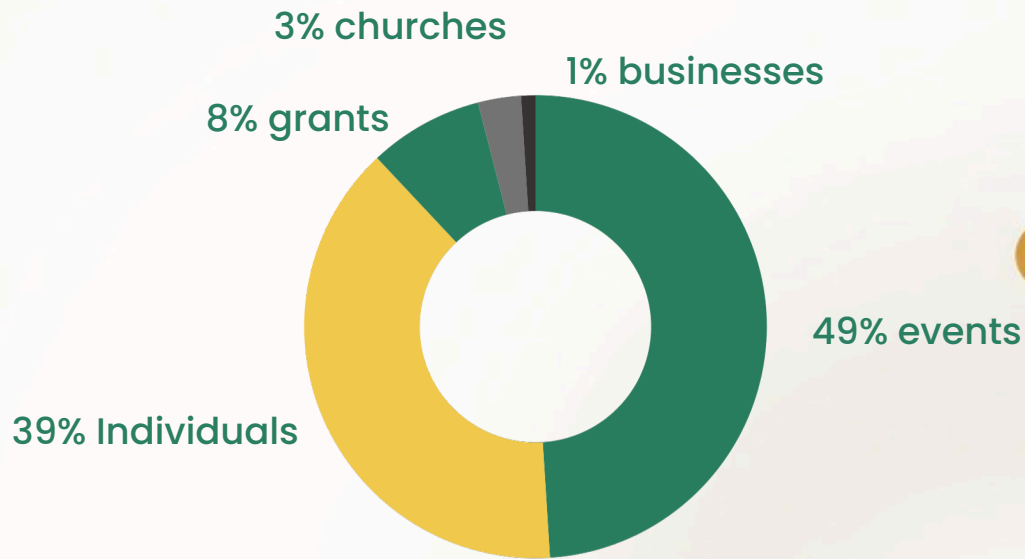
**Professional Training**
