
2022 IMPACT


Bridge of Hope (BOH) is ending homelessness for single mothers and their children in the Greater Denver Area by:

- Helping families obtain safe and long-term housing.
- Providing professional case management focused on building life skills, career development, and budgeting.
- Partnering each family with a team of volunteers from a Christian faith community who provide support, encouragement and friendship.

Over a one-to two year period, this combination of resources empowers families to become self-sufficient so that they never face homelessness again.


